Extension Notice- Student Thesis Research Grant Request for Proposal

09 October, 2025

National Trust for Nature Conservation (NTNC) has extended the call for proposals from final-year Bachelor's and Master's students to conduct research as a requirement for the partial fulfillment of their academic degrees. The initial submission deadline September 26, 2025 has now been extended to October 31, 2025 (5:00 PM). Previously submitted proposals will be considered, and applicants do not need to re-submit.
