Conservation Scientist Dr. Naresh Subedi has been renominated as the Member Secretary of the National Trust for Nature Conservation (NTNC). He is appointed to the post in accordance with the provisions of the National Trust for Nature Conservation Act, 1982 (2039 BS). Dr. Subedi has been dedicated to the Trust for the past 25 years previously served in the role of senior Director.

Dr. Subedi has made exceptional contributions to nature conservation and biodiversity in Nepal. A milestone of his leadership is the recent decision by the Government of Nepal to entrust the management of the Central Zoo in Lalitpur to NTNC for an additional 30 years—a result of his special initiative and proactive coordination. Furthermore, his leadership and international outreach have successfully attracted more than 200 various donor-funded projects to the Trust, significantly strengthening Nepal's conservation initiatives.

Dr. Subedi also holds a formidable presence in the fields of academia and research. He has published nearly 200 high-level research works and has successfully mentored more than two dozen scholars in their PhD research. With his deep expertise in conservation science and management, it is expected that under Dr. Subedi's leadership, the Trust will achieve new innovative and strategic milestones in nature conservation, wildlife management, and climate change adaptation.
